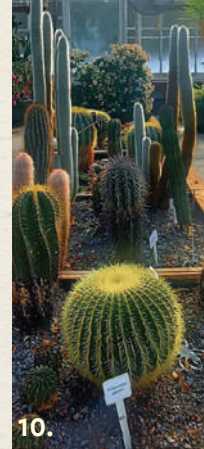

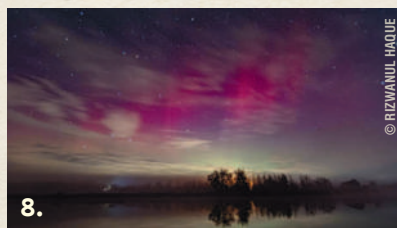

Explore this walkable region on foot! In the heart of our historic downtown on Prescott St, pick up a coffee at a local cafe like **Bubba & Bugs Coffee Bar** or **The Crusty Baker**. Enjoy the murals down by the Kemptville Creek and take notice of the heritage architecture of buildings like The Armoury on Ruben St, and "**The Bank of Ottawa Building**" now home to The Book Store, where you can find almost anything!

At the tip of Prescott and Clothier St you have to stop and see the **Giant Adirondack Chair** in Rotary Park. (You can find one in every hamlet of North Grenville!) Make your way down to the water following the path from Rotary Park or stroll down Clothier St to **Curry Park** for the **Waterfront Trail** and **Kayak launch**.



You can't go wrong with any of the restaurants, cafes, and bars in the hub of the Downtown Kemptville BIA - Prescott St, Clothier St, and Sanders St are home to international flavours, like **K-Sushi**, a local favourite bringing authentic Korean techniques, quality, and precision to their fares. **Z'amore** is a new addition to Downtown Kemptville, bringing the welcoming atmosphere of a scratch Italian diner with an elevated flare making it a great spot for date nights and celebrations.

If you're looking for something a little off the beaten path you can, head down Clothier St to **Grahames Bakery**, Grahames is quintessential to the area having the oldest commercial wood-burning stove, operating as a bakery since 1885! Our Favourite is the rustic Purple Wheat Sourdough loaf! Notable mentions include **Hyde Smokehouse & Bar** for after hours, and **Salamanders** for their iconic waterfront patio.



Downtown Kemptville features a really unique mix of historic architecture, cozy boutique shops, restaurants, and green-space. Steps away from Prescott St is **Riverside Park** with ample parking. Here you can find a great Playground, Twin Pickle Ball/Tennis Courts, an Outdoor Pool, The Splashpad, Ball Diamonds and a Skateboard Park. It's a central hub of activity for both locals and visitors alike with major events like **Canada Day** and the **Kemptville Winter Carnival** also taking place here.

Some of the best shopping happens in just a few blocks, including **Mama's Cheeky Co Boutique**, a curated clothing boutique with a mix of trendy and timeless pieces, another gem is **Sugold Jewellers**, here you can shop one of a kind pieces, or grab a quick gift, (p.s they do watch batteries so you can take that off your to do list while you're downtown!). **The Village Pets Boutique** is also worth the visit if you're planning on adventuring the region with a furry friend - everything pet care can be found here!
